## Essential Job Functions:

Performs regular teacher's class plan while the teacher is absent, including but not limited to the following:

- Reports to the school office at the beginning of school day to pick up required materials/schedule of classes and at the end of the school day to return materials.
- Carries out a program of study prescribed in the lesson plans left by the classroom teacher. The lessons may be face-to-face in the class, virtual online, or hybrid (some students in class and some students virtual)
- Creates a classroom environment that is conducive to learning and appropriate to the maturity and interests of the students.
- Guides the learning process toward the achievement of curriculum goals and objectives as indicated in the lesson plans for the lessons, units, or projects assigned.
- Employs instructional methods and materials that are most appropriate for meeting lesson objectives.
- Maintains a neat and orderly classroom.
- Takes attendance in accordance with school procedures.
- Indicates to students at the beginning of class the basic expectations for behavior in the class in accordance with the school Policy.
- Ensures that the students are never left unattended in the classroom.
- May perform duties usually required of the absent teacher such as lunchroom duty, hall monitoring, etc.
- Follows school procedures and regulations.
- Consults, as appropriate, with the principal or department head, before initiating any teaching or other procedures not specified in the lesson plans.
- Maintains appropriate records including checking test papers, recording grades, student assignments for homework, projects and the necessary clerical work required to maintain student records for a teacher who is absent.
- Performs other related duties as directed by the principal.
