Sign up will take place in two consecutive sessions: 1st session will allow parents to sign up maximum of two activities, 2nd session will allow them to sign up total of four activities. **Please note** system will accept maximum 4 activities during each quarter for each child. The confirmation of the activities depends on the actual class size of the enrollment. If we have to cancel an activity due to small class size, notification will sent home via email to parents in this regards.

All Parents MUST sign the “Permission to Participate” form. We would like to collect this form at the beginning of the year, which will remain valid throughout the year. If any of the information changes over the year, please contact the activities office to update your information.

The cost for activities is included in tuition. On occasion an ASA may have to cancel or postpone a single day of a class because of unforeseen circumstances. It is not unusual that certain classes run for four/five weeks instead of six.

Please note, that ALL elementary ASA's will run regardless of a hartal being called.

Transportation will be provided after weekday activities to those students who live in the Gulshan-Banani-Baridhara neighborhoods only. **No transportation will be provided on Friday or Saturday. Parents are responsible for weekend activities.**

Please be advised that transport by bus is our standard arrangement for students in our elementary After School Activities (ASAs) program. We monitor student attendance very carefully from the beginning of activities to bus loading time after the activities. These measures ensure a safe routine for your child after school.

If parents pick up a child without notice to the school, there is serious concern among the after school staff while we search for the “missing” child. During the search we also hold bus departures in case the “missing” child is found at school.

ASA BUS: To avoid unnecessary concern and delays, please inform the school of any changes you desire to your child's transport plan. If you wish to make an alternative transport arrangement for your child you must inform the school as follows:

1. To remove your child from the ASA bus roster for the duration of activities for the Quarter, or
2. To change your child's ASA bus plan for one day only,
submit your **INSTRUCTION IN WRITING** to Ms. Kavya Zahid (Elementary Office) or Ms. Joya Ambarin (Activities Office) or Mr. Obaid (Transport office).
3. To pick up your child from ASA without prior written notice, please see Joya Ambarin or Transport Officer before you leave, so she/he can note this on the daily bus roster.

Thank you in advance for helping the ASA staff staying informed of your child's transport plans.
